COURT BOOKS

- 1 Honour of SKIPTON, court leet and court baron: 1825-1882
business of the court includes return of constables for townships within the honour, presentment of defaulters, swearing in of pinders.
- 2 Manor of ESHTON, court baron: business of the 1741-1764
court includes presentments for neglect of fences etc., and for default.
Note: the court is recorded only six times in this period.
- 3 Manor of SILSDEN, court leet and court baron with 1752-1882
view of frankpledge: business of the court includes detailed presentments, notices of heriot due, making and confirming of bye-laws, swearing in of manorial officers.
- 4 Manor of STIRTON CUM THORLEY, court halmote and 1753-1882
court baron: business of the court includes detailed presentments, making and confirming of bye-laws, swearing in of manorial officers.
- 5 Manor of GARRAVE, court baron: business of the 1761
court includes detailed presentments, making of bye-laws.
