INTRODUCTION

This collection, purchased by West Yorkshire Archive Service at Christie's in 1983, relates to the estate of the Wentworth family of Woolley Hall. The Yorkshire Archaeological Society already holds an important collection of medieval deeds relating to Woolley, Arthington and Creskeld and Notton with some later estate papers (DD57), some further estate papers 18-19 cent.
