1. SILSDEN MAP DD 214 Size: 68" x 76" 1757
Scale: 1" : 5 chains
Endorsed: 'A Plan of the Manor & Lordship of Silsden'.

Gives 2 tables of tenants. Numbers refer to numbers in the Field Book which gives quantity & quality of each piece of land, description of principal marks & Bounder Stones. It includes the Ancient Bounds of Holden Park (a red dotted line). Buildings in red. [Parchment - coloured] (FRAGILE)

Scale: 1" : 10 chains
Gives acreages, buildings, roads, etc. (Resurveyed 1892. Pub. 1898)

Scale: 1" : 6 chains

Gives acreage, which is mostly the property of Sir Richard Tufton, Bart. A few roads & buildings are marked. [Parchment. Coloured] (FRAGILE)

Scale: 1" : 4 chains

Gives acreages and descriptions of land. (Most is property of Sir R Tufton, Bart.) Gives roads, some buildings, and purchase date of 'Planks or Platts' - 1846. [Parchment. Coloured]

Gives acreages, ownership of land & date purchased, description of land, roads,
railways, marked with the estates of Westmorland, Crosby, Ravensworth, Oxon.,
Brougham, Kirkby Thore, etc. [Paper. FRAGILE]

Size:
Scale: 6" : 1 mile
Westmorland, showing some lands coloured. Covers Kirkby Stephen,
Ravenstonedale, Mallerstang, etc. Boundaries of Swaledale.
