1. 1595. 8 Oct. Deed of Partition whereby a house and part of a parcel of ground called Lairebell in Stanghowe are granted to Thomas Hebbourne and Frances his wife.
2. 1628. 21 Aug. Bargain and Sale. Thomas and William Hebbourne to Robert Hebbourne - a messuage and an oxgang of land in Stanghow. Bond for performance.
3. 1628. 23 Aug. Confirmation by deed poll (livery endorsed) from Thomas and William to Robert - above premises.
4. 1656. 3 May. Feoffment (with livery) John Chapman to William Westland. Conveyance of Lairebell in Stanghow. Bond for performance.
5. 1669. 16 Apl. Deed poll (livery endorsed) William Westland to Elizabeth Hebbbran. Half of a close called Larebell in Stanghow.
6. 1672. 8 Feb. Bargain and Sale (with livery) William Chapman and Mary his wife to John Chapman. A messuage and half the Lairebell in Stanghow.
7. 1672. 17 Feb. Bargain and Sale (with livery) William Chapman and Mary to John Pinder. Half an oxgang called Pond close in Stanghow.
